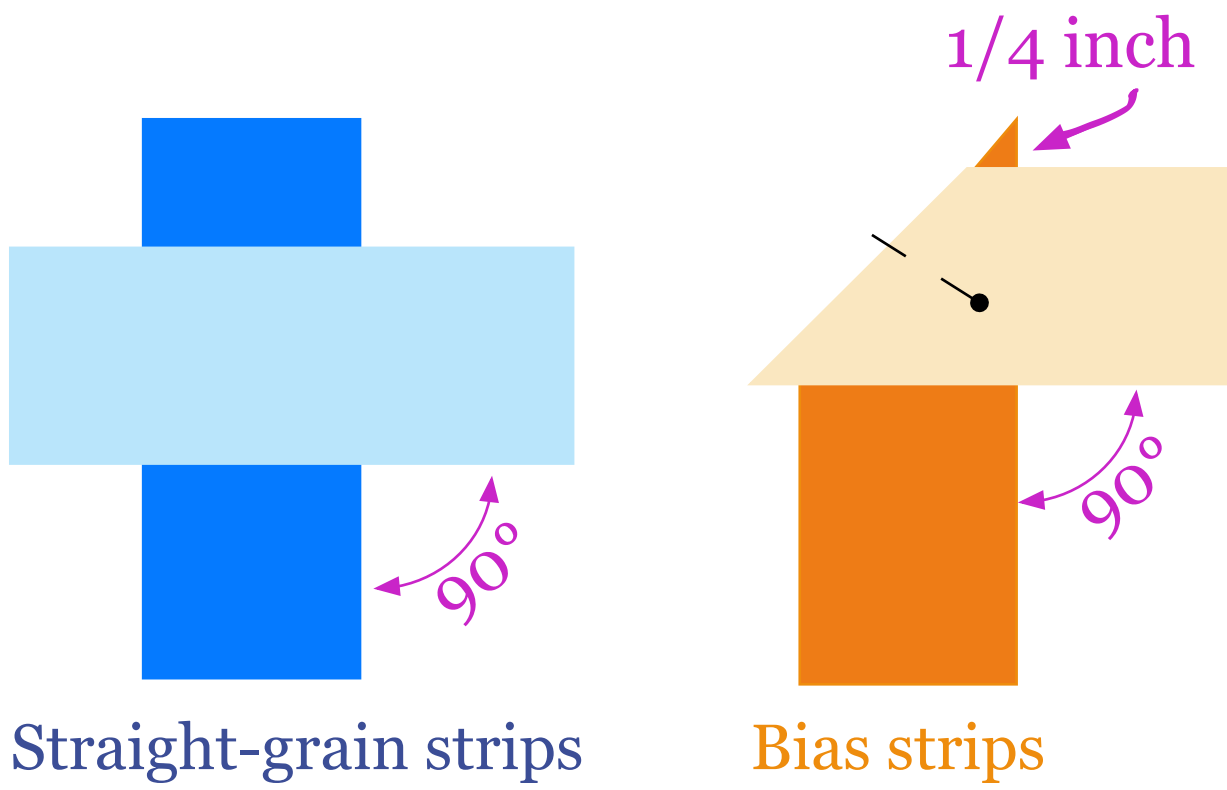
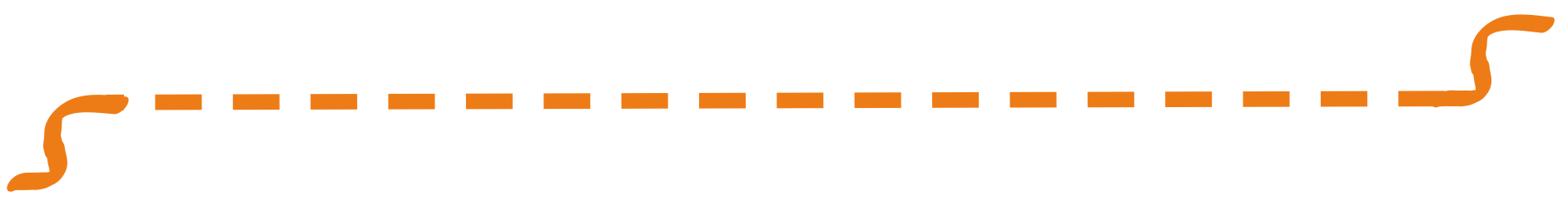


Join Strips with Diagonal Seams

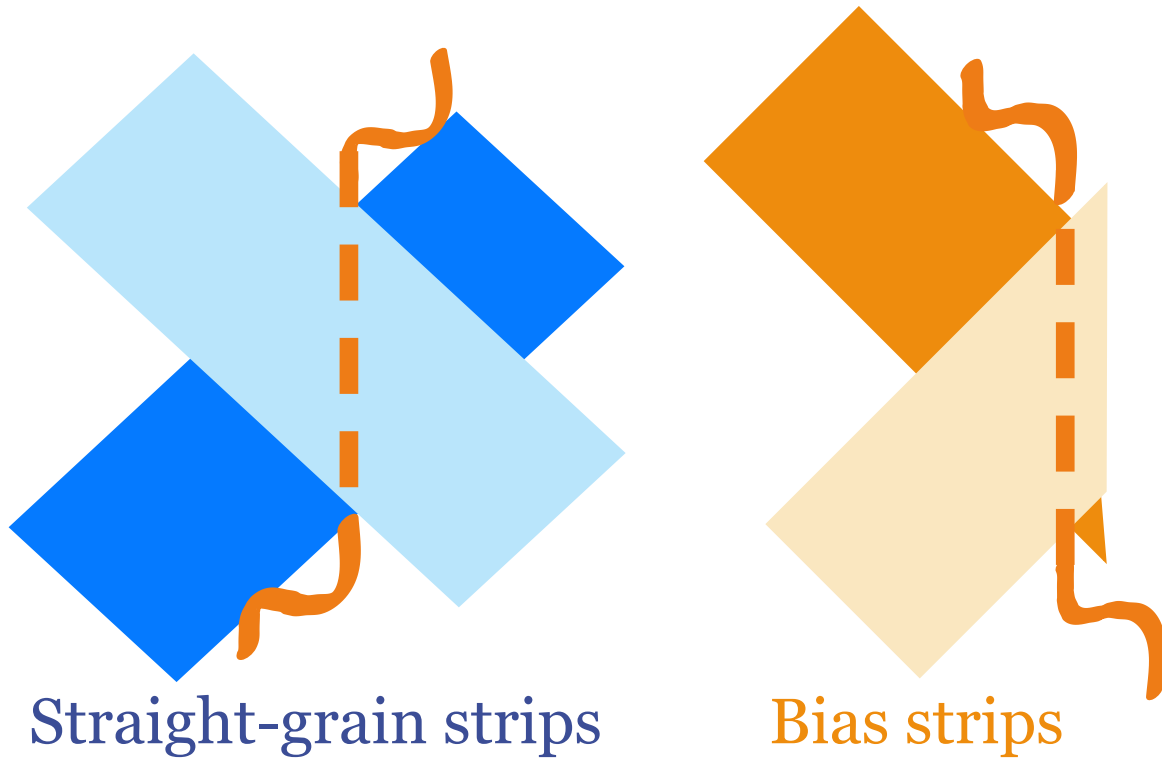
straight-grain strips • bias strips

Strips joined with diagonal seams are preferred by many quilters because they are less noticeable than straight seams.

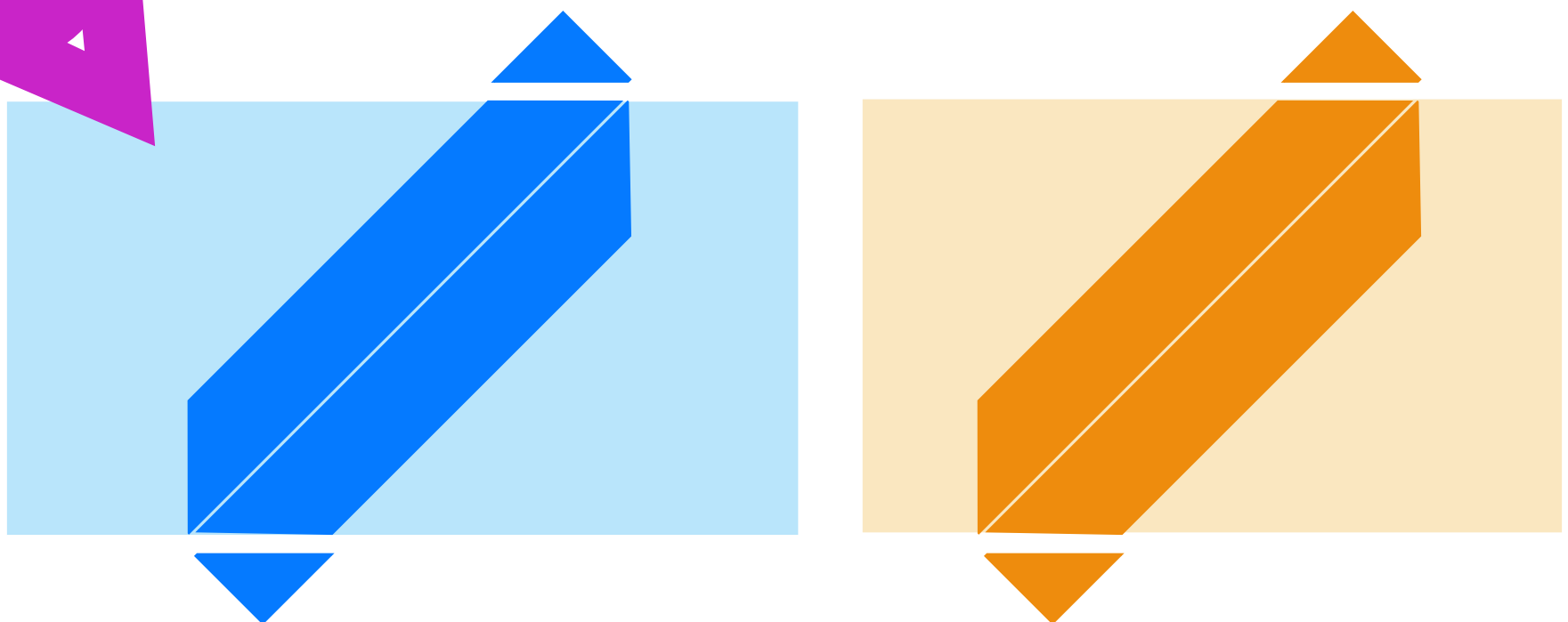
Be aware — Straight-grain strips joined with a diagonal seam may require additional fabric because strips are trimmed after joining.



Right sides together, overlap the ends of the two strips as shown, to make a perfect right angle — If you'd like, pin to hold in place.



Sew from corner to corner.
 Trim straight-grain strip seam to 1/4".



Press seam open. Trim the points to remove fabric bulk.
